

How to get to CUH CEDAR Building

Driving from City Centre

Take the N22 from Washington Street. Continue through Dennehy's Cross onto Wilton Road/R641. Turn left (before the Pedestrian Crossing) onto Liam Lynch Park. The CUH CEDAR Building will be on your right. There is a patient car park next to the CUH CEDAR Building.

Driving from Bishopstown

Pass Cork University Hospital entrance on your left. Continue to the Wilton Roundabout and take the 2nd exit onto Glasheen Road/R849. Take the 1st left onto Liam Lynch Park. Take the next left and the CUH CEDAR Building will be on your left. There is a patient car park next to the CUH CEDAR Building.

Driving from West Cork

Take the N71 to Cork. At the Bandon Road Roundabout take the 3rd exit, keep left. At the Sarsfield Road Roundabout take the 1st exit onto Sarsfield Road/R641. Continue to the Wilton Road Roundabout. Take the 3rd exit onto Glasheen Road. Take the 1st left onto Liam Lynch Park. Take the next left and the CEDAR Building will be on your left. There is a patient car park next to the CUH CEDAR Building.

Driving from the South Ring Road

Follow the N40. At the Sarsfield Road Roundabout take the 3rd exit onto Sarsfield Road/R641. Continue to the Wilton Road Roundabout. Take the 3rd exit onto Glasheen Road. Take the 1st left onto Liam Lynch Park. Take the next left and the CEDAR Building will be on your left. There is a patient car park next to the CUH CEDAR Building.
